It is time to look toward Spring and our annual Bordeaux BYOB. This year, we will explore St. Julien – including **Leoville Las Cases, Ducru Beaucaillou, Gruaud Larose and Talbot**. As usual, we ask that each attendee bring a minimum of one bottle. We prefer that you bring wines at least ten years old. We will also accept Leoville Barton '96, '95, '94, '90, '89, '86, '85, '82, '61, and '59 and Leoville Poyferre – '96, '90 and '82.

The event will be held at the wonderful Beacon Restaurant. Acclaimed chef Waldy Malouf has received high praise from critics for his delicious roasted and grilled dishes. The dinner menu was carefully selected to enhance our enjoyment of the wines.


We will start with a champagne reception and hors d'oeuvres, including wood roasted oysters; crabcakes with a spicy remoulade; smoked salmon; and Waldy's grilled four cheese pizza topped with wild mushrooms and fresh basil. Our dinner menu includes "Tici" (unique rolled pasta) in a Wild Boar Sauce; wood roasted Squab with Morels; a spectacular Baby Spring Lamb course; and a Chocolate Ganache layer cake with Vanilla Crunch and Brandied ice cream.


