In 1982, with a Vocational Training Certificate in Oenology for Montpellier Agricultural Highschool and a Business Training Certificate to his name, he left for Canada. He spent a year at a winery in British Columbia, where he perfected his knowledge of English.

Upon his return to France in 1983, he joined the Angers Chamber of Agriculture.

In 1985, he became the cellar master and vineyard supervisor at Château Pichon-Longueville. He has been the Technical Director since 1987. With his team, he devotes all his skills and painstaking efforts to producing a great Pauillac wine.
