Buddakan is currently one of the most popular restaurants in New York. For good reason. The atmosphere inside Buddakan is electric. The delicious cuisine incorporates interesting ingredients resulting in intriguing tastes. We are delighted to be able to hold two dinners there on September 25 and October 2, 2007.

Each dinner will have over 14 separate dishes. Please look at the attached menu. Among the dishes to be served are Edamame dumplings steamed in Sauternes with caramelized shallots, glazed Alaskan Black Cod with Chili eggplant and black bean relish, General Tso's chicken dumplings with ginger and garlic, Tuna spring rolls, Peking duck salad, shrimp and lobster chow fun in X.O. sauce and Mongolian Lamb chops with a delicious crystallized ginger crust.

The dinners will be held in the magnificent "Chinoiserie" room, a great hall with oak carved walls two stories high and huge chandeliers. It is a lovely dramatic setting. Seating will be at a large banquet table in the center of the room.
